Earl Joseph Hubenthal, 98, passed away February 24, 2015 at his residence in Dexter, Missouri.

He was born August 3, 1916 in St. Louis, Missouri to Joseph and Marie (Stahl) Hubenthal.

Earl and Myrtle bowled together for many years and received gold medals in mixed doubles in bowling in the 2003 Senior Olympics in Virginia.
